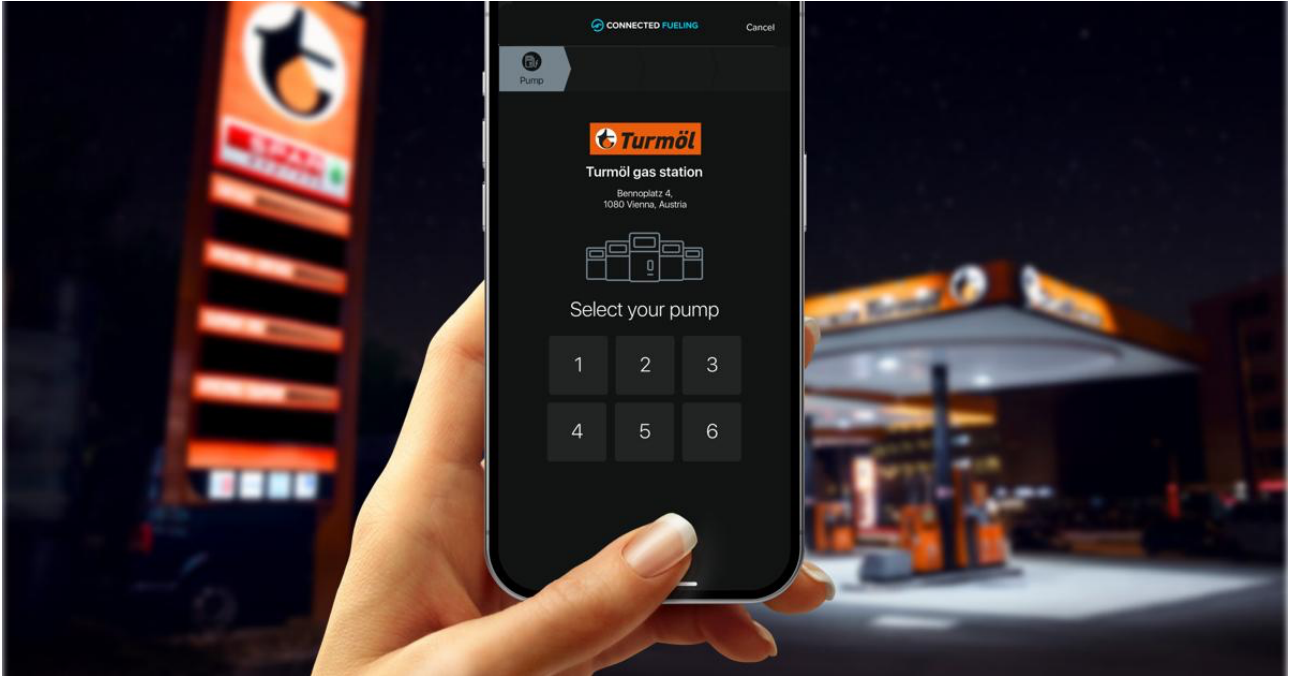


PACE and Turmöl Cooperate: Mobile Payment at Turmöl Gas Stations in Austria now Possible



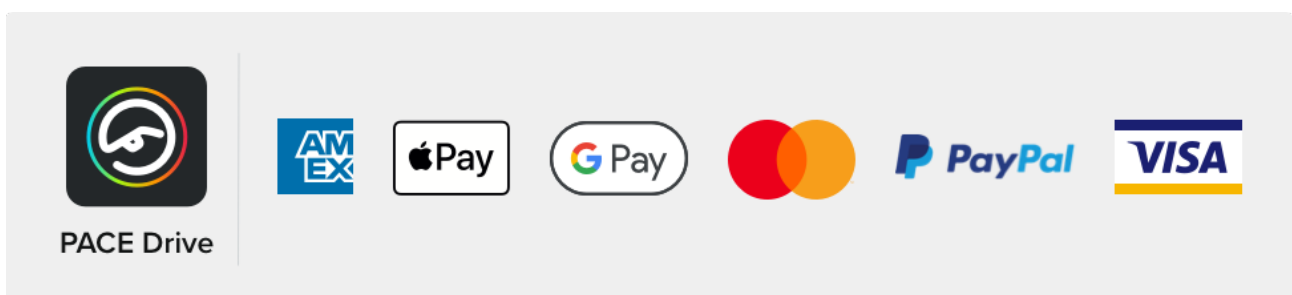
Karlsruhe/Wels 24.04.2024 – The technology company PACE Telematics, based in Karlsruhe, Germany, has achieved a leading position in the field of mobile payment solutions at fuel pumps in Europe with its pioneering, cloud-based Connected Fueling platform. Recently, PACE Telematics announced its collaboration with Turmöl, one of the leading gas station operators in Austria. Thanks to this partnership, drivers can now pay directly at the pump via their smartphone, smartwatch, or their vehicle's infotainment system using the PACE Drive App at approximately 130 Turmöl stations in Austria.

The in-app payment process is quick and easy:

1. Once users arrive at the desired fuel station, they select their preferred fuel pump.
2. They fill up as usual and authorize the transaction using their preferred payment method.
3. The journey continues. Receipts are archived in the app and sent via e-mail.

Thanks to a two-stage authorization process and data encryption, data security is guaranteed at all times.

The PACE Drive app is available free of charge from the Google Play Store and the Apple App Store and can be used on the smartphone, smartwatch and via Apple CarPlay and Android Auto directly in the vehicle. In addition to giropay (for Germany) it supports a variety of payment methods, including AMEX, Apple Pay, Google Pay, Mastercard, PayPal and VISA. Users can enter their preferred payment methods during registration and then use them directly in the app.

Turmöl operates 267 petrol stations in Austria, making it one of the largest gas station operators in the country.
